

**Temporary Road Closure Order
Town Police Clauses Act 1847**

IN ACCORDANCE with Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, which section gives Wiltshire Council ("the Council") the power to make an Order for roads within its administrative area to be closed temporarily to all vehicular traffic (and for alternative routes to be observed) for the purposes of preventing obstruction.

The Council HEREBY ORDERS

On: **Sunday 11th November 2018** between the hours of **10.00 and 12.00 (midday)**

Purpose: **Remembrance Sunday Service**

That the following roads and streets in the town of **Sherston** are to be closed (save in any case of emergency) to all vehicular traffic:-

- a) **Green Lane**; from its junction with Court Street to its junction with Sandpits Lane.
- b) **C68 Court Street**; from its junction with Green Lane to its junction with B4040 High Street.
- c) **Cliff Road**; from its junction with C68 Court Street to its junction with Silver Street.
- d) **Silver Street**; from its junction with Cliff Road to its junction with B4040 Brook Hill.
- e) **B4040 (Part) High Street / Church Street**; from its junction with Silver Street to its junction with Easton Town.

Nothing in this Order shall prevent vehicles from proceeding in the said length of road when being used in connection with the event stated above.

AND it is also hereby ordered that appropriately sign posted diversionary routes will be in place throughout the period of closure.
