Property known as Sherston Old School (the 'Old School')

On 26 October 2010 the Parish Council borrowed a sum of £250,000 from the Public Works Loans Board to help finance the purchase of the Old School. Interest of 4.19% is payable on the loan and repayments are over 50 years at a fixed half yearly amount of £5,990.94 first due on 26 April 2011. The loan is shown in these accounts as income. No provision is made in these accounts for interest accrued but not paid at 31st March 2011.

On 25 March 2011 the Parish Council transferred a sum of £223,000, plus fees and stamp duty of £21,253, to solicitors in relation to the imminent purchase of the Old School. This sum is included in these accounts as a part of bank and cash balances.

On 1 April 2011, but not included in these accounts, the Parish Council completed the purchase of the Old School for a sum of £363,000 and immediately leased the premises to Sherston Old School Community Interest Company (SOSCIC) for a premium of £140,000 and a rental of £12,000 pa payable half yearly for 50 years commencing October 2012. SOSCIC is responsible under the lease for the preservation and enhancement of the Old School.

The Parish Council resolved at its meeting on 13 January 2011 that the sum of £50,000 granted to it in March 2009 by North Wiltshire District Council would be formally transferred to funds allocated for the Old School.

As a result of these transactions, and immediately following the purchase of the Old School on 1 April 2011, the Parish Council has reserves earmarked for the Old School as follows:
